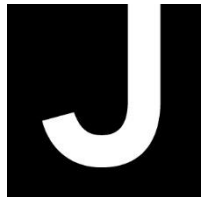


Position: Junior Camp Counselor

Position Summary

Our summer camp is seeking an energetic, accountable Junior Camp Counselor to provide a safe and memorable experience for our campers. The ideal candidate will be an excellent multitasker with a genuine passion for working with and empowering young people. Counselors work up to 7.5-hour days between the hours of 8:00 am – 5:30 pm Monday – Friday. Dates are June 15 - August 14, 2026 (with training sessions June 7-13, 2026).

Salary: \$13.50-\$14.50/hour dependent on education and experience

General Responsibilities:

- Being conscious of and protecting the health, safety and welfare of all campers in any area or programs at camp. Being able to assist campers in an emergency.
- Lead small and large group activities.
- Supervise campers' participation in structured and unstructured activities.
- Appropriately model behavior and use positive behavior-management techniques - enthusiasm, sense of humor, patience, and self-control.
- Attend all staff meetings, orientation, open house, special and camp-wide programs, group-specific late nights, overnights, and field trips, as designated by the Camp Director.
- Perform other duties as requested or required, whether specifically mentioned in this job description or not
- The ability to work effectively with others in all levels of the organization in a professional manner
- Positive attitude

Qualifications:

- 16 years of age or older
- Working papers (if under 18)
- Previous experience working with children, examples include but are not limited to; babysitting, academic/athletic tutoring, camp counselor, youth volunteer, classroom assistant, teacher
- Commitment to work the full 8 weeks of camp (absences for school or other reasons are handled on a case-by-case basis by the Camp Director).
