Pharoah!

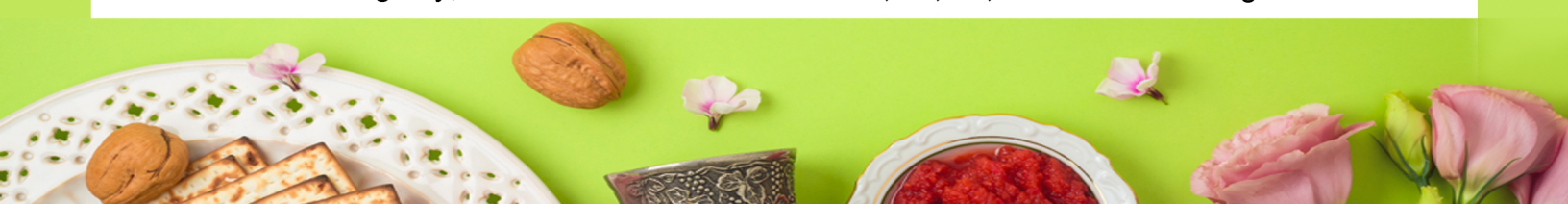
Oh listen, oh listen Please let my people
